were both achieved on modest budgets through a successful interactive community process and have been embraced by their local communities. Ms. Eizenberg leads the design effort of the practice and was the recipient of the 2012 AIA Los Angeles Gold Medal in recognition of a lasting influence on the theory and practice of architecture.
